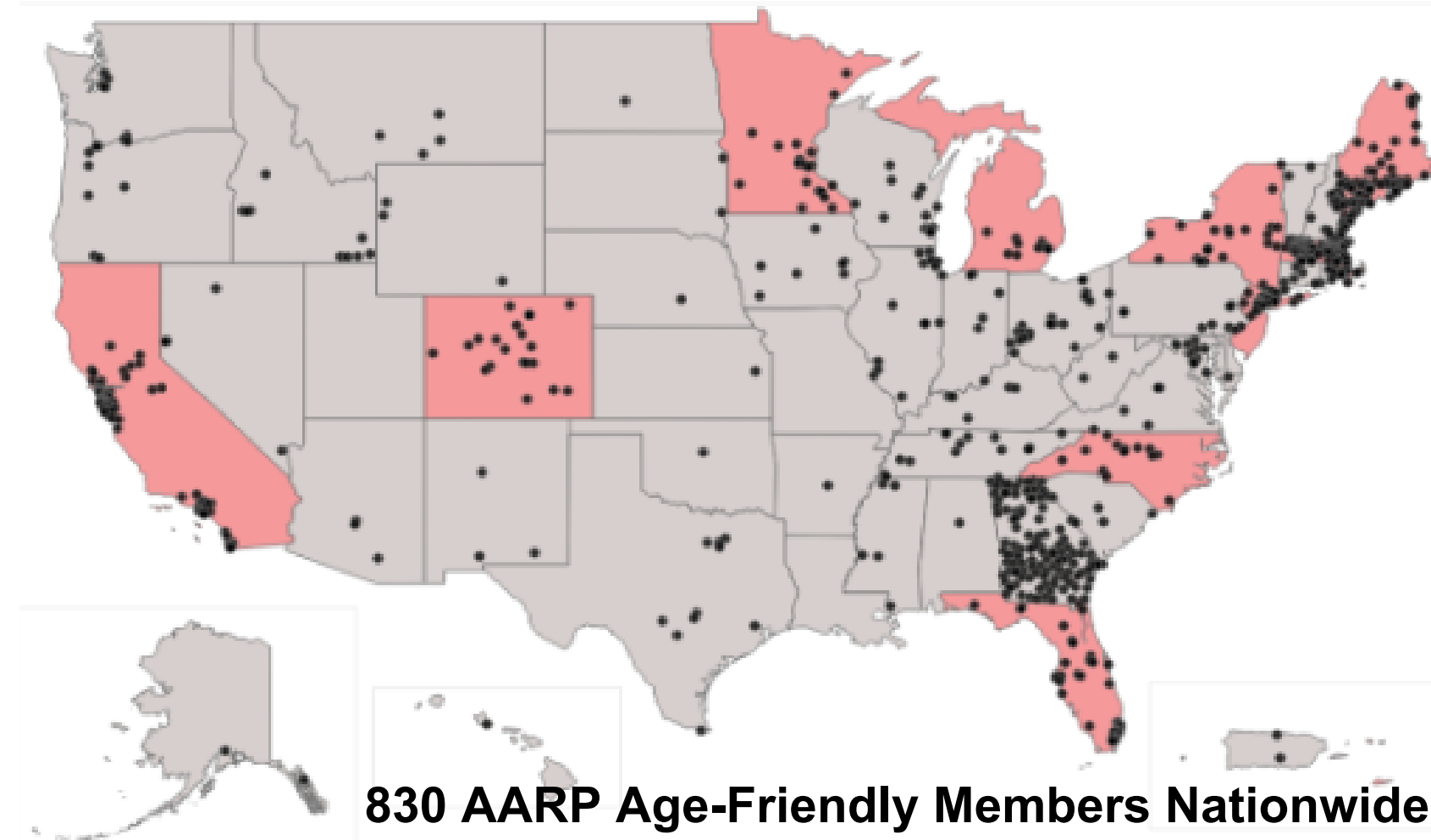
The WHO Global Network for Age-friendly Cities and Communities currently includes 1542 cities and communities in 51 countries, covering over 320 million people worldwide.



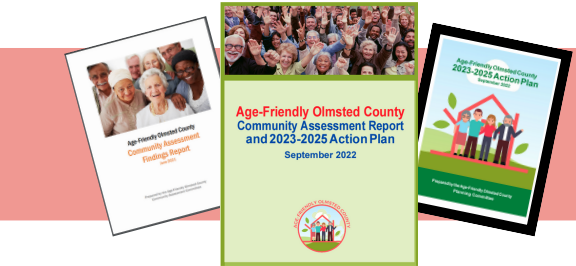
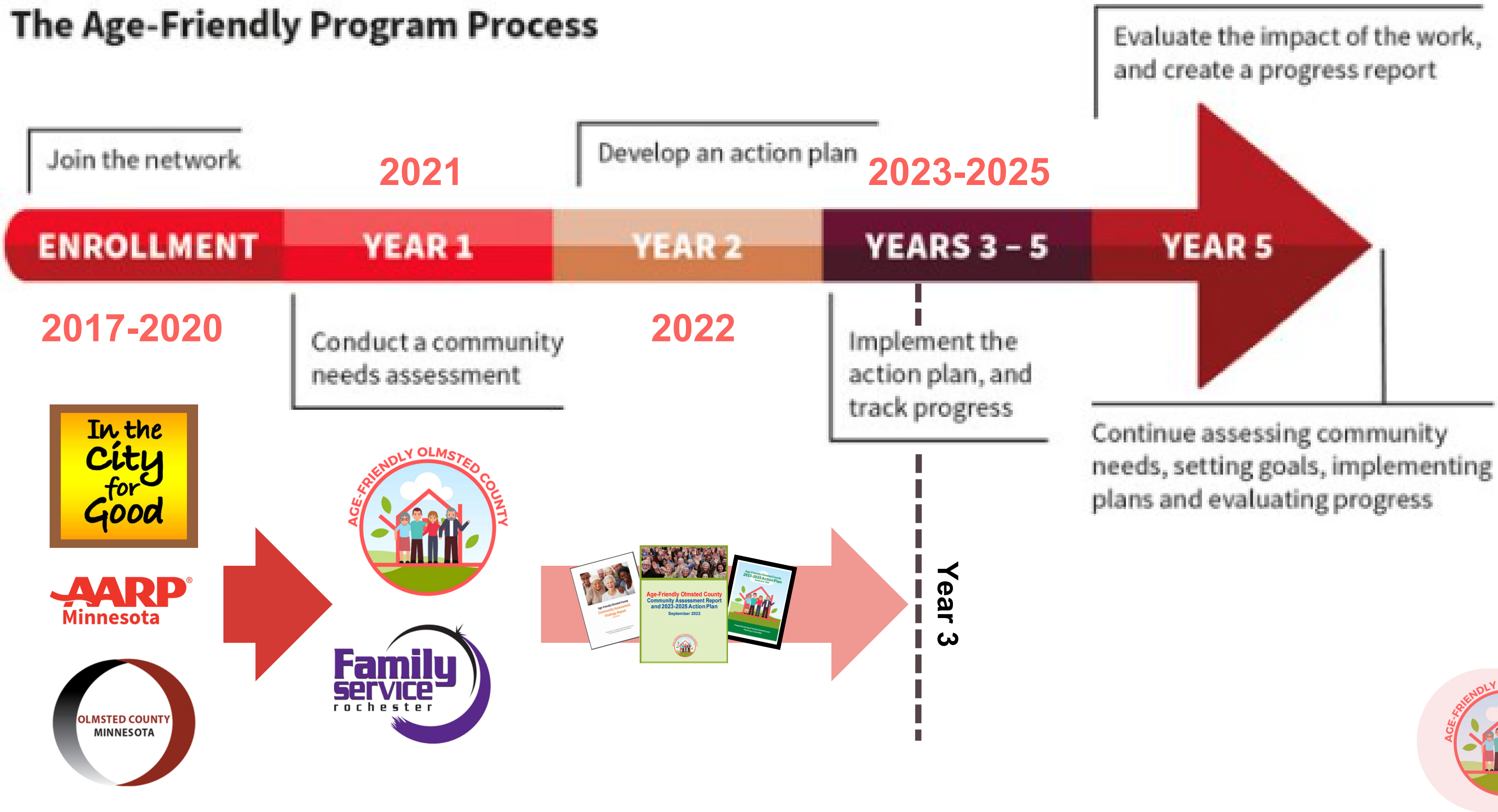

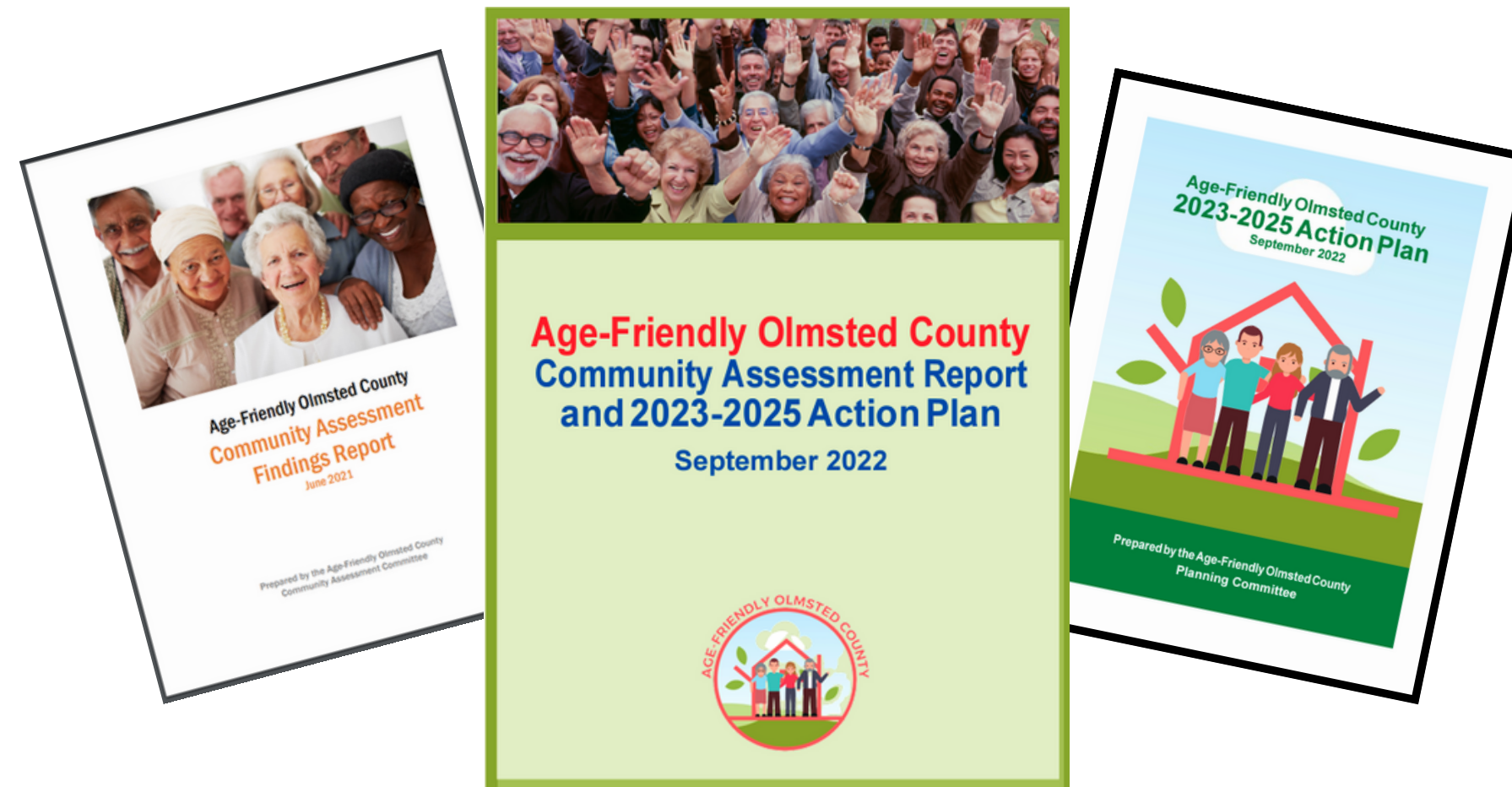


The Age-Friendly Program Process

A new Live Well at Home Grant Extension was created to provide ongoing funding for projects and services with proven outcomes for older adults and persons with dementia. The grant extension improves statewide capacity, sustainability, and stability for home and community-based services and family caregiver supports.

Caregiver Support and Respite Services



Caregiver Support Services provide individualized coaching and counseling to help caregivers develop caregiving skills, connect with resources, and maintain a healthy, balanced lifestyle.



Caregiver Respite Services provide safety, companionship, supervision, and other non-medical services that allow the primary caregiver time away for other activities.

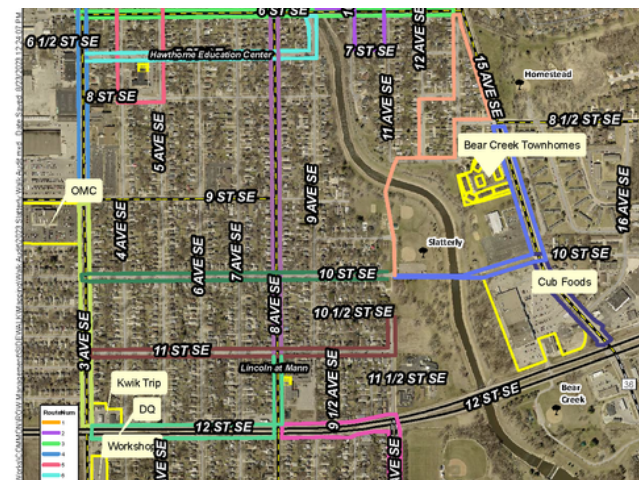

Increased Interest in Aging Actively

- 14.4% of Olmsted County residents were 65+ in 2015
- According to a 2013 survey, issues related to aging (elderhealth) was cited as one of the most pressing community health issues in Olmsted county

Implications for Parks & Recreation

- More senior recreation
- More mid-day recreation programs
- Less strenuous outdoor recreation- more walking, gardening, culture, etc.
- Desire for volunteer opportunities
